### Taybeh- Jericho Road ( Al Muarajat)

#### **PROJECT AIM (OVERALL OBJECTIVE)**

This project aims to rehabilitate section 3 " Al Muarajat " of the road that connects Taybeh and Jericho cities with a total length of 2,000 meters.

#### **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

UNDP/PAPP has been approached by the Government of Japan and the Palestinian Authority to directly execute the road rehabilitation for one section with a total length of around 2,000 meters.

UNDP/PAPP will be responsible for the rehabilitation of the third section with a total budget of US\$ 1,320,801. This section is considered to be the most dangerous sections with a high rate of car accidents. Twenty-five percent (25%) of accidents took place in this section.

The Three remaining sections will also need of major rehabilitation, once additional funds are secured. The estimated additional funds are 7.2 million to rehabilitate the remaining road length 19,500 meter run.

Rehabilitation of 2 kilometers of the Taybeh – Jericho Road (Al Muarajat)

#### **IMPACT STATEMENT**

Enhance People's safety by reducing car accidents in using Taybeh-Jericho road (Al Muarajat) through the rehabilitation of the most dangerous section of the Road.
