PROJECT AIM (OVERALL OBJECTIVE)

The project is in response to the immense need to develop the long-neglected education system and youth services in the occupied Palestinian territory and in the wave of rising unemployment.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The programme includes employment creation through the provision of educational infrastructure and youth service programmes in three clusters of rural areas including eleven villages in the northern districts of Jenin and Qalqilia, with a total population of approximately 23,000.

OBJECTIVES

- To create immediate job opportunities through a set of labor-intensive infrastructure development interventions that will generate approximately 30,857 skilled and unskilled person workdays
- To increase the capacity of and improve the conditions of educational facilities through the construction or rehabilitation of schools and providing access of youth to these facilities.
- To strengthen community interactions by promoting the schools as a center for community and youth development

IMPACT STATEMENT

The overall impact is to facilitate and improve access to basic education and youth services in poor rural communities through the creation of short-term employment opportunities in labor-intensive education infrastructure development.
