The programme aims to provide immediate humanitarian relief to Palestinians through the construction, rehabilitation, & equipping of Primary & Secondary Public Schools in the West Bank.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project funded by the Government of Japan was based upon the 2004 Consolidated Appeals Process (CAP) whereas UN agencies submitted project proposals that were part of a humanitarian appeal. Based upon this submission, the Government of Japan identified a number of projects that were submitted by UNDP/PAPP as being worthy of further discussions. After careful review of the various project interventions, and negotiations, this project was approved and funded.
