### Germany funds a rehabilitation project at Al Quds University in Abu Dis

Mr. Miguel Berger, the German Representative to the Palestinian Authority, Dr. Sari Nusseibeh, Head of Al Quds University, and Mr. Timothy Rothermel, UNDP Special Representative, will inaugurate a landscaping project at the university on Monday, 28th November, at 12.00 o'clock at Al Quds University in Abu Dis.

Germany is funding the rehabilitation of the university landscape with 100,000 Euro. The works will not only rehabilitate the paths, staircases and the main courtyard at the university, but will also create 2667 working days for the residents of Abu Dis.

This Emergency Response Project is part of the recently signed Phase 3 of the Poverty Oriented Employment Generation Programme (EGP) through which the German government aims to create jobs and improve the living conditions of the Palestinian people.
